 -15' indicates a minimum of 15' of isolation is required.
 -10% rule can be used to mitigate isolation requirements.

Isolation Requirements Summary (from Handbook 2014)

Annual Ryegrass *

This distance must be maintained from all varieties of Ryegrass (Annual, Intermediate, and Perennial), Meadow fescue and Festulolium of the same ploidy level. Isolation between diploids and tetraploids shall be no less than 15 feet.

Intermediate Ryegrass *

This distance must be maintained from all varieties of Ryegrass (Annual, Intermediate, and Perennial), Meadow fescue and Festulolium of the same ploidy level. Isolation between diploids and tetraploids shall be no less than 15 feet. See section IV, D in the OSCS Handbook.

Foundation and Registered fields of Intermediate ryegrass must be isolated 300 ft. from tall fescue. Border removal is allowed for fields over five acres.

Perennial Ryegrass *

This distance must be maintained from all varieties of Ryegrass (Annual, Intermediate, and Perennial), Meadow fescue and Festulolium of the same ploidy level. Isolation between diploids and tetraploids shall be no less than 15 feet. See section IV, D in the OSCS Handbook.

Foundation and Registered fields of Intermediate ryegrass must be isolated 300 ft. from tall fescue. Border removal is allowed for fields over five acres.

Meadow Fescue *

Must be isolated from Meadow fescue, Festulolium and all Ryegrasses. Isolation is required at the Foundation and Registered classes against Tall fescue.

Festulolium *

Distance must be maintained from all Annual, Intermediate and Perennial ryegrasses, and Meadow fescue of the same ploidy level. Isolation between diploid and tetraploid Festuloliums shall be no less than 15 feet.

Tall fescue *

Isolation is required at the Foundation and Registered classes against Meadow fescue.

* - Requires isolation distances from like crop of the following

Foundation	1320 / 900 ft. (<5 acres / >5 acres)
Registered	660 ft./ 300 ft.
Certified	330 ft./ 165 ft.
